Community raves about the addition of Gama Sonic Solar Lights

"Matt did a great job of selling us on the mechanics on how the lights work and operate," Lamb said. "We didn't even inquire about another brand. We just made the decision to buy, and a year later we purchased for one community and then three months later we bought them for two others."

Genoa Way, located in Houston, is a manufactured home community with 134 homes, while Sherwood, which has about 100 manufactured homes, and Bay Breeze Mobile Home Park, a community of 67 homes, are located in Baytown, Texas.

Lamb admitted he was a little concerned when it came to installing the lights, and safety was of the utmost importance. He told the maintenance crew that if children came and jumped up on the poles, he wanted to make sure it wouldn't fall over. Much to his surprise, the installation process was easy. He said the crew dug some small holes and poured concrete. "We're not experts at this type of thing, but it turned out to be very simple. And it was quick too. We got 30 to 40 lights installed in a matter of a few days," he added.

While the ease of installation certainly influenced Lamb's decision to purchase more Gama Sonic lights for two of his other communities, he said the bigger reason was the fact that the lights were so well received by the residents. Lamb explained that they installed the lights in phases, and once they finished just one street in Genoa Way, Lamb said every single resident came into the office to ask when they would get their new lights. The residents raved about the lights and the way they look, and Lamb said they're planning to add more lights in the future.

When asked if he is satisfied with the [Gama Sonic Imperial II solar outdoor lights](#), Lamb responded with, absolutely. "I'm very happy with the product," he added. "I'm a believer."
