


Crystal Glass Stainless Steel Solar Pathway Light

IMPORTANT: PLEASE DOUBLE CHECK THE CONTENTS BEFORE DISCARDING THE PACKAGE TO PREVENT MISSING PARTS NEEDED FOR ASSEMBLY.

Installation/Operation

1. Peel off the film covering the solar panel so that the solar panel can get full sunlight.
2. With the lamp head upside down, remove the battery cap by twisting counter clockwise.
3. Install the battery with the positive side sticking out.
4. Re-install the battery cap by twisting clockwise until the lamp turns on.
5. If you wish to turn the lamp off, twist the battery cap counter clockwise until it turns off.
6. Insert the stake into the pole (Note: the stake may be installed pointing inside the pole in the packaging. Remove it and install so the stake is facing out.)
7. Insert the lamp head into the pole.
8. Insert the lamp assembly into the ground in a spot where it will receive direct sunlight.



Replacing the Battery

1. Remove the lamp head from the pole.
2. Unscrew the battery cap and remove the old battery.
3. Insert a new 1.2V Rechargeable AA Ni-Cd or Ni-MH battery.
4. Screw the battery cap back on and re-install the lamp head on the pole.

Troubleshooting

If light doesn't turn on, remove battery, wipe the copper plate in the middle of the battery cover with an eraser, and reinstall battery. Check the battery to ensure that it is making secure contact with the terminals. If this doesn't work, replace with new battery.

WARNING: Do not dispose of batteries in municipal waste stream or by fire as batteries may explode. Do not open, short circuit, or mutilate batteries. Dispose of batteries in accordance with Local, State, and Federal regulations. Contains no toxic metals. Do not mix old and new batteries.
